







#### **PSCC Board Meeting Minutes on September 18, 2023**

Held on Zoom

Present were Chris Currie, Mary Tevis, Yvonne Shimek, Henry Heerschap, Michael Hrankowski, and Mercedes Perez

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm.

The minutes of August 21, 2023, were moved to be accepted, were seconded, and passed into the record.

#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Chris Currie reported that the Edmonds waterfront center show has now sold Currie will pick up the prints at MountLake Terrace show. five images as Jack Broom has now sold one. The exhibit is to be taken down on October 3, 2023, between 4:00 pm and 5:30 pm.

The last astrophotography field trip took place on September 16, 2023. Chris Currie led it and reports there were seven people.

#### **VICE-PRESIDENT'S REPORT:**

Mercedes Perez reports that after conferring with the field trip committee, they decided to look at Kubota Gardens as a field trip, and details will be emailed to the club members.

#### TREASURER'S REPORT:

Yvonne Shimek reports that there is \$1376.58 as of August 30, 2023, in the club account. The Visual Pursuits website has started and the old website will end when we are completely switched. The report was moved, seconded, and passed into the record.

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS:**

Visual Pursuits is being updated by the committee. The club will get a email status update soon.

The PSA Inter-Club competition entries are due 11-15-23, 02-15-24, and 04-15-24, and due to Dave Patzwald 11-01-23, 02-01-24, and 04-01-24. The club will be sent email a month before.

Voting for two color and two black and white at the last print night turned out well, and was much less confusing. It was decided to continue this voting method. We also discussed entering the Travel Photography category, and it was decided that we would wait until next year to talk about it again. Henry Heerschap will pick up the prints at Lakeshore showing, and Chris

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

To be done after Visual Pursuits is up and running at the end of the year. There has been discussion about dissatisfaction with the judging system at both digital night and print night. Should we refine the numerical span to allow for finer differences between images? If so, are there other systems we can use? A committee, headed by Henry Heerschap, and including Lauren Heerschap, Michael Hrankowski, Mary Tevis, and Bob Joiner, will look into different judging methods to perhaps be incorporated into Visual Pursuits. The next Board meeting will be held by Zoom on October 16, 2023, at 7:00 pm.
