How to look up your images scores and critiques.

To look up your image scores and critiques, log onto the club website and click on My Account/ Image History. For images in the last month, click on the "Load Recent Image History" button. To go back further, click on Image Search Options. Go down to Competition Dates to set the desired period.

Note that you will only see Critiques for Print Night beginning in August 2025. Print Night critique scores are an average of the three inperson judges.






