Current News tab. In addition to the normal monthly meetings, you will find a number of upcoming field trips including:

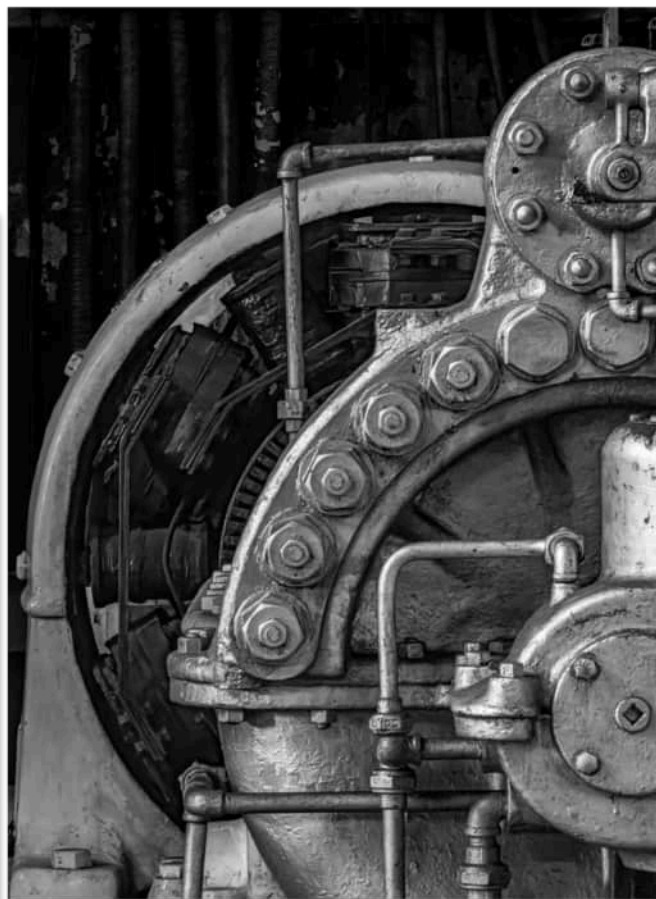
- July 12 Cascadia Iris Gardens

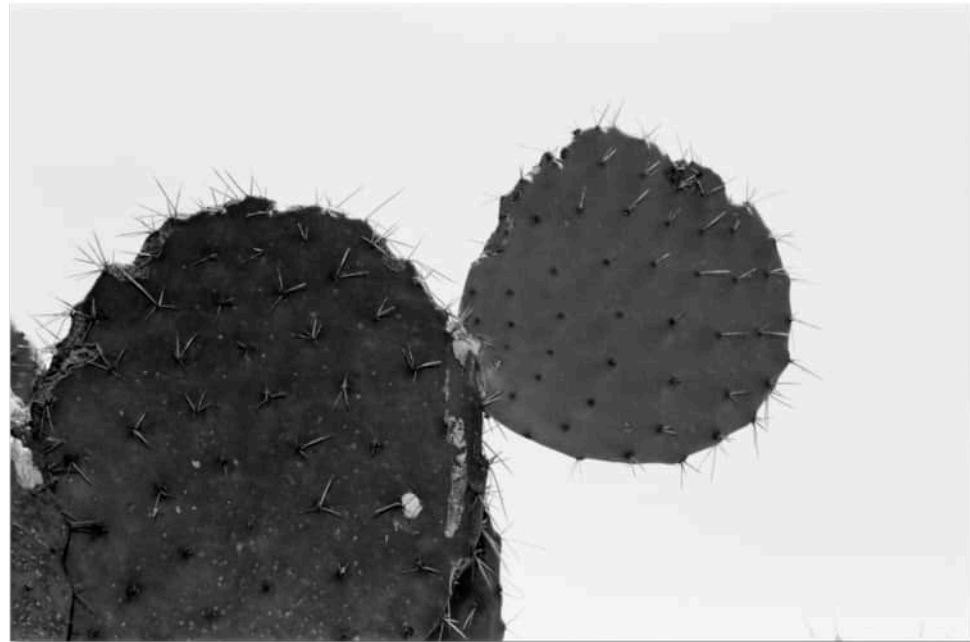

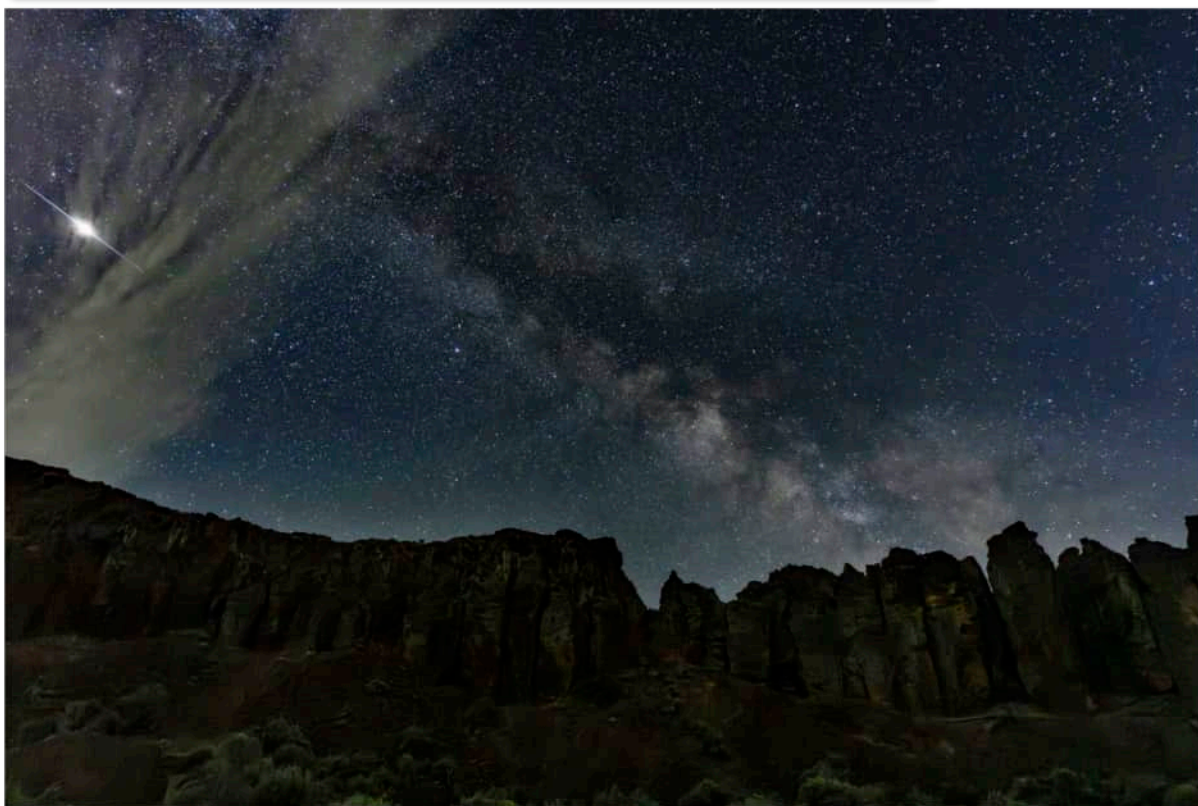

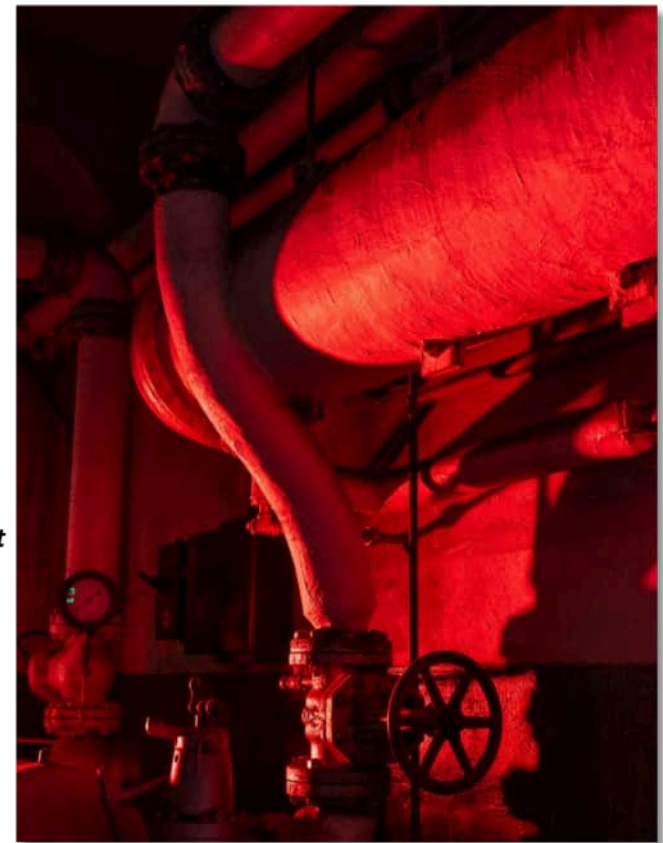




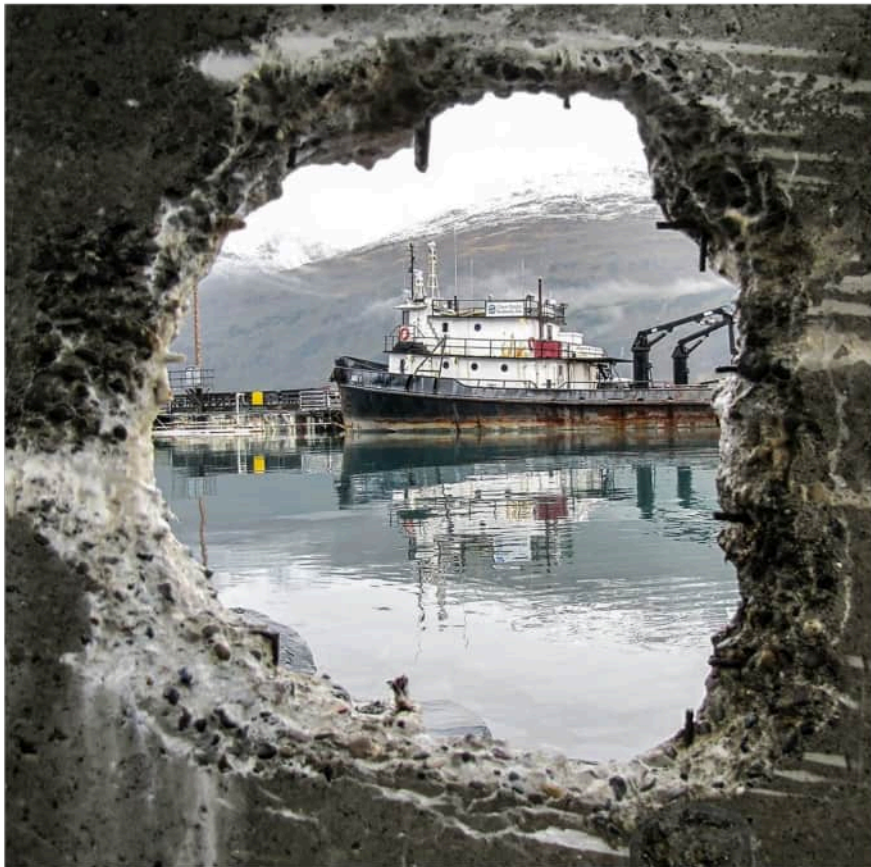

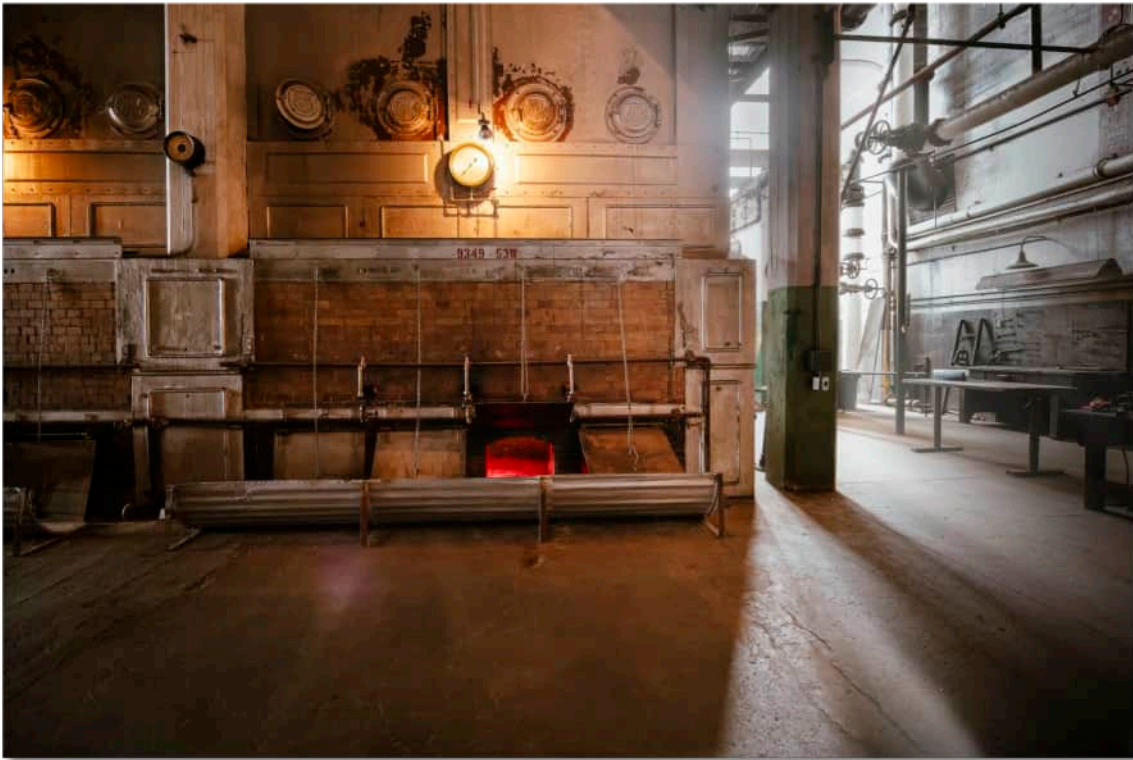
