













PSCC Board Meeting - July 15, 2024 - Submitted by Daniel Grundel, secretary

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 PM.

2. Attendance

Present: Chris Currie, Dave Patzwald, Yvonne Shimek, Henry Heerschap, Lauren Heerschap, Mercedes Perez, Michael Hrankowski, Bob Sotak, Daniel Grundel

3. Approval of Minutes

Motion: Chris Currie moved to accept the minutes from the June meeting.

Seconded: Bob Sotak **Result**: Motion passed

4. President's Report (Chris Currie)

- Expressed satisfaction with the end-of-year meeting and thanked Lauren for organizing the taco bar.
- Reported that judging for F67 club went well, with Henry, Bob, and Chris participating in judging via Zoom.
- Henry provided updates on SPS and the NW Council:
 - SPS judging was completed by Lauren, Michael, and Henry over the course of 4 hours. There were over 200 images, both digital and print.
 - Northwest Council update:
 - David Johnson continues as interim president.
 - Conference scheduled for November 9 in Anacortes.
 - NW Council board meeting is on July 20.
 - They are still seeking a secretary.

5. Vice President's Report (Mercedes Perez)

- Education Night speaker options:
 - Stephanie Johnson (fee: \$200)
 - Tony Sweet (negotiated fee: \$250, exceeds budget)
 - Mike Moats (fee unknown)
 - Andy Royce (potentially lower cost)
- Discussion on potentially increasing attendee fee and involving other clubs to share costs.
- Next education night is July 29. Henry will present on Infrared Photography.

6. Treasurer's Report (Yvonne Shimek)

- Current balance: \$2,259.49
- Need for an annual audit of the books (1-2 hour commitment).

7. Unfinished Business

A. Visual Pursuits issues:

- Gallery ordering and scoring display problems reported.
- Discussion on People's Choice scoring and tie-breaking.

Motion: Henry moved to allow two votes per category for People's Choice digital to reduce need for tie-breaking.

Result: Motion passed. Bob will implement the change.

B. Judging Committee update:

- On pause due to summer schedules.
- Plan to resume after Labor Day.

C. PSA Image Evaluation Course:

- Potential late October/early November timing.
- Free course offered by Jen Fawkes.

D. Image quality issues in Visual Pursuits:

- Members advised to resize images before submission.
- Suggestion for education on proper image sizing and Visual Pursuits usage.

8. New Business

A. PSA PID (Projected Image Division) Competition:

- Competition start: November 15
- · Current categories: Color, Monochrome
- Additional categories are available for entry; Dave suggested we enter an additional category, Travel (General)

Motion: Henry moved to add Travel category to our entries.

Seconded: Michael **Result:** Motion passed

B. Year-end Competition Rules:

• It was suggested that year-end competition rules be amended to prevent the same image winning in multiple categories.

Motion: Henry moved to disallow submitting the same image in both print and digital yearend competitions.

Result: Motion passed C. Ice Cream Social:

- Scheduled for August 12 at 6:30 PM.
- Lauren to arrange ice cream bars and sandwiches.

D. Digital Night Scoring Display:

Lauren suggested the addition of scores or winners to the Digital Night slideshow.
 Members of the board and attendees had many mixed opinions.

Motion: To keep current practice of not displaying scores on Digital Night.

Result: Motion passed

E. Member Survey:

- Proposal to gather feedback on club activities, training needs, and field trip ideas.
- Henry is planning to create and send the survey electronically.

F. Field Trips:

- Suggestion for a raptor center visit (possibly \$40-50 per person) with "The Falconer."
- Chris to gauge interest at next Digital Night.
